
A Comprehensive Guide to the CELPIP Writing Task and Task 2





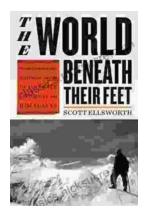
